This funding will be used to

- Support the transition of young children into the schooling environment through key early years' strategies: transition statement process, community playgroup, pre-prep program, community links and early years providers.
- Improve students' literacy outcomes through the implementation of targeted, student-driven and data-driven reading intervention pathways and the introduction of Prep Oracy Program.
- Conduct ongoing staff development in the areas of Australian Curriculum, Strategic Thinking Agenda and Coaching in reading and best pedagogical practices.
- Build staff capacity in emotional intellegience, purposeful dialogue, leading others and building teams through targeted professional development opportunities.

Our initiatives include

- Continuing our Community Playgroup (and community parnterships with JABIRU and CityHope Church) ensuring high quality programming aligned to EYLP, AAP and 3a.
- Continuing to embed/review the reading framework with all staff. Tracking and monitoring student progress long term and short term.
- Using data to determine "students at risk" with literacy and provide more intensive in-class support, with tighter review cycles and smaller groupings.
- Identifying specific areas of support from LLI, synthetic phonics, Foundations of Reading and Oral literacy. Ensuring TAs have access to support and PD and are resourced appropriately.
- Conitnuing to offer Collaborative Conversation Time (CCT) allowing for Yr Level Planning/Coaching/Sharing and Mentoring to occur.
